Description



TAM 115 is a new dryland wheat with improved disease resistance and growth for grazing during winter months. It is geared to produce dual purpose wheat for favorable grazing and grain or forage yield. TAM 115's water use efficiency is excellent. It is resistant to leaf rust, stripe rust, stem rust, green bug, and curl mite. For grain only or grazing-grain operations, this variety has the resistances and drought tolerance to perform exceptionally well under dryland and irrigated conditions.
