WB Winterhawk is a medium hard red winter wheat with superior drought tolerance and winter hardiness making this wheat an elite choice for moisture deficient areas. This wheat is one of the most consistent wheats for dryland in the Texas Panhandle. WB Winterhawk has quick emergence in the fall season for excellent grazing and grain yields. This variety has favorable straw strength and remarkable test weight.
