Tambar 500 barley for silage, grazing or grain. Grain yields with Tambar 500 are consistent. It is excellent grazing through fall and winter. For silage the protein and digestibility are good on this barley because of the amount of leaves it holds. Harvest in the boot stage for best feed value. Tambar 500 is salt tolerant.
